Mountain Emergency Medicine (MEM) Course Winter including the AHEMS topics according to DiMM regulations (ICAR, ISMM, UIAA).

- You must be able to master the following knots prior the course: italian hitch, figure of 8, clove hitch, overhand slip knot, fisherman knot, prusik
