Minimum requirement

Course participants must be able to swim a distance of at least 25 meters. Please contact Oliver Kreuzer if you do not meet these requirements.

Course material

All course material specific for the Helicopter Underwater Escape Training (wetsuit, swim mask, etc.) will be provided by the organization.

For the practical part of the course in the water you need to bring the following personal course material with you:

- Swim suit
- 2 towels
